ABOUT THE TEQIP-III

Technical Education Quality Improvement Program (TEQIP) was envisaged as a long-term Program of about 10-12 years duration to be implemented in 2-3 phases for transformation of the Technical Education System with the World Bank assistance. TEQIP-III is fully integrated with the Twelfth Five-year Plan objectives for Technical Education as a key component for improving the quality of Engineering Education in existing institutions with a special consideration for Low Income States and Special Category States and support to strengthen few affiliated technical universities to improve their policy, academic and management practices. The third phase of the project, TEQIP-III is a four-year Central Sector Scheme (CSS) of MHRD, Govt. of India, started in the year 2017 and will be ended in 2021.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

This workshop on "Academic Writing Skills" is primarily targeted at research scholars / academicians in providing useful insights about writing good quality of research paper. Scientific papers are considered as an important indicator to measure the research out-

put / performance of an individual, institution and also a country. Researchers publish their research findings mainly in the form of articles / papers in scientific and technical journals. This indicator is directly linked to the career of an individual researcher and also an institution for getting funds, recognition etc. Writing a good project or thesis is an art as well as a sophisticated knowledge based skill.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The workshop is designed to facilitate the initial phase of designing and planning a quality project in the engineering and technology by giving students a clear overview of the basic elements common to a thesis in various disciplines. The course will introduce the Five Essential Elements of a Thesis (issue, contexts, texts, methodology and voice). After introducing these concepts, the workshop will give students the opportunity to articulate these concepts in their own projects, and to receive feedback from staff and students in the course. Dedicated periods for learning, working individually with academic mentors, exchanging drafts, and providing their peers with constructive feedback, may helpful to develop

the skills of identifying the basic elements of description, analysis ,argument, and incorporating these elements in their own writing practice.

OUTCOME OF THE WORKSHOP

Participants of this workshop will be equipped with the use and applicability of scientific literature review and gain knowledge about writing and submitting their thesis within scientific and improved manner. After the workshop students may able to –

- become familiar with core components of a thesis.
- learn how to justify choice of particular methodological approaches, and selection of texts.
- learn to identify differences between description, analysis and argument while writing.
