P G Certificate Course in Environment & Sustainable Development

Under Section 38 (2 and 3)

1. P G certificate course in Environment & Sustainable Development is designed to create the awareness in this emerging area, so as to give an impetus to research/action research, activities in the field of Sustainable Development and application of Science & Technology for Sustainable Development
2. **Admissions :**
Candidates who have obtained the Bachelor or equivalent Degree in Science/Engineering/Agriculture from any recognized university/recognized institute shall be eligible for admission.
3. This being a sensitizing course, no Migration or Transfer Certificate is required to be submitted at the time of admission in the course.
4. **Duration :**
The duration of the certificate course shall be three months consisting of theory and Project Work.
5. **Attendance :**
Candidate undergoing the course shall be required to attend 85% of the lectures delivered and Project Work carried out, provided that a short fall in attendance up to 10% may be condoned by the Vice Chancellor.
6. **Examination :**
For the award of the Certificate, the candidate has to appear and successfully pass; the examination at the end of the duration of the course. The examination will consist of two parts (a) **Theory** (b) **Project work** as per the scheme of the course.
7. **Passing the Examination :**
A candidate shall be successful if he/she obtains minimum 35% marks in each theory paper and 60% in project work. However, the candidate to be declared to have passed the said examination for award of the Certificate, he/she shall have to obtain minimum 50% marks in aggregate.
8. if a candidate is unable to pass exam, he/she shall clear the examination in next consecutive two attempts. If the candidate fails to appear in the examination as mentioned above, he/she may loose his/her chance of any further opportunity being given to him/her.
9. The division in which a candidate is placed shall be determined on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in total of all the theory paper and project work as follow:

(a)	Second Division	50% to 65%
(b)	First Division	65% to 75%
(c)	Honors	Above 75%
